Business Survival Among the Fittest

The Small Business & Entrepreneurship Council (SBE Council) recently announced what the Nevada Development Authority and local entrepreneurs have known for years – Las Vegas is open for business with one of the best business climates in the U.S.! The SBE Council released its 14th annual rankings of the states according to their public policy climates for small business and entrepreneurship in the “Small Business Survival Index 2009: Ranking the Policy Environment for Entrepreneurship Across the Nation.” Nevada was ranked number two with the most favorable business climate in the United States.

The “Small Business Survival Index” helps business owners and investors understand public policy burdens placed on entrepreneurship and small business and ranks each state accordingly. The factors included in the index and ranked individually for all states are taxes, various regulatory costs, government spending, property rights, healthcare and energy costs.

Contributing to Nevada’s business-friendly ranking are the state’s no corporate or personal income tax policies and low workers’ compensation fees, for which Nevada was placed in the top 10. Coming in at first place, Nevada was ranked as the state with the least full-time state and local government employees per 100 residents. Nevada was also among the top 20 states for the lowest amount of state and local property taxes, local government expenditures and local government five-year spending trends.

The Small Business Survival Index is one of many accolades Nevada receives for its business climate. At the NDA, our job is

to promote these favorable statistics to encourage businesses to relocate or expand to Southern Nevada. The infrastructure that made Las Vegas great is still here and as we come out of this recession, Southern Nevada will already have the needed tools to show our nation the way to a successful economy.

Another area of promotion we are working on is marketing Las Vegas. What the Las Vegas Convention & Visitors Authority (LVCVA) does for the tourist industry, the NDA will do for the business community. We are constantly thinking of new campaigns to keep and project Southern Nevada in a positive light. New Chancellor For Higher Education Speaks at January Breakfast

“It’s Time to Build a New Nevada - Higher Education, the Economy and the Future of Nevada” was the message newly-appointed chancellor, Dan Klaich, of the Nevada System of Higher Education delivered at the Nevada Development Authority’s breakfast on Thursday, January 21, 2010. Mr. Klaich spoke of the benefits of higher education expressing not only an educated workforce for Southern Nevada, but also a decrease in social services and prison costs. “It’s an investment for our future,” reiterated Klaich, “We can no longer rely on state funding for our students, we need help from the business community.”

With the less than optimistic report from the recent Economic Forum hearing held in Carson City, higher education was hoping to see better numbers in spite of last year’s drop from 19.3% to 15.6%. “Usually education has garnered at least 21% in healthier economic years,” Klaich reminded the audience. Undergraduate fees have increased by 39% in recent years.

Fear of having to turn away students for lack of sufficient funding has championed Mr. Klaich in petitioning the business backbone of our community. “We need collaboration directly from our community to succeed,” says Klaich. He went on to express that the business

community needs to change their perception from looking at higher education funding not only from a return on investment standpoint, but also from a partnership perspective. Mr. Klaich believes business and education will lead us out of this recession.

The breakfast was held at the Four Seasons Hotel Las Vegas and was attended by NDA members, state and local officials and guests.

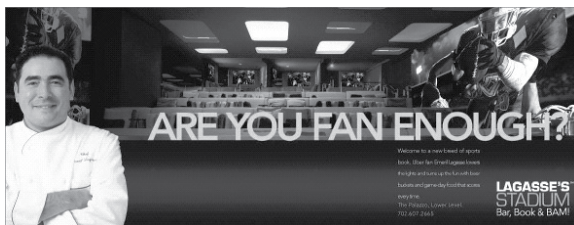
