## LVCVA Partners With NDA to Attract Business

Live, Work, Play - Las Vegas...the Best Business Climate in the U.S., is the theme in place at the Las Vegas Convention Center. Nevada Development Authority (NDA) is partnering with the Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority (LVCVA) with the focus on attracting more business to Southern Nevada.

The partnership will provide the NDA with permanent booth space in the Las Vegas Convention Center to promote the advantages of moving a business to Southern Nevada. The group charged with attracting new businesses to Southern Nevada will have an audience with more than 1.5 million business travelers who visit the convention center every year. The NDA will also have the opportunity to partner with the LVCVA on corporate marketing efforts and events.

“Las Vegas is once again breaking new ground in partnering our convention and tourism industry with our economic development industry to help the local economy,” said Rossi Ralenkotter, president/CEO of the LVCVA. “The tourism industry already provides hundreds of millions of dollars to the community through the visitor-paid room tax, and this is another way for us to help bring business here.”

“The amount of commerce and the level of businesses represented at the conventions held there is a tremendous opportunity for us,” said Somer Hollingsworth, president & CEO of the NDA. “We are thrilled to have the chance to reach out to the audience at the convention center.”



Along with these proactive steps the NDA is taking with the LVCVA, NDA has recently launched a new ad campaign with the creative help of Terry Shonkwiler of Shonkwiler Partners. The TV spots featuring talking orangutans are aimed towards California. “Now more than ever is the right time to have your business move to Las Vegas,” said Hollingsworth. The ads legitimately state that Vegas has the best business climate in the U.S.

The past fiscal year of 2009/2010 we have had 317 visits for potential new businesses as opposed to 284 in 2008/2009. With the help of the NDA, Las Vegas gained 2,058 new jobs last year alone.

**Economic Development is an Investment  
in Our Future**

As a lobbyist for the Nevada Development Authority at the Nevada Legislature, Russell Rowe, Esq., has been on the front lines with the NDA in its effort to expand our state's business sector and diversify our economy. Founder of The Capitol Company, a public policy and government affairs firm in Las Vegas and Reno/Carson City, Russell has represented the NDA with respect to advancing economic development and diversification goals at the state level since 2001.

As is well known by Nevada's business community, the Great Recession is having a devastating impact on Nevada businesses as well as on state and local governments. Nevada's unemployment rate leads the nation, while government coffers have emptied dramatically with the reduced tax revenue and demand for greater services during tough economic times. While these reports make the news on a seemingly daily basis, what is more important to business is how the State of Nevada intends to move forward and set itself on a course for sustainable economic growth.

Of no surprise to those in the business community, key to any meaningful, long-term prosperity is the creation of permanent jobs. Job growth not only brings new consumers to the market and creates new tax revenue for state and local governments, but it also reduces the demand for government assistance. Consequently, for each job created the economy receives a double shot in the arm while the pressure on state and local governments is lessened.

For the NDA, job growth through economic development and diversification is the essence of its mission. Over the previous fiscal year alone the NDA created 1,265 new, direct jobs in Southern Nevada with an average wage of \$24.56 per hour (the state average wage was \$20.05) with an overall employee economic impact of \$331,595,658. Moreover, the creation of these jobs will provide an estimated \$39.5 million in local tax revenue and \$10 million in state tax revenue over the next 5 years.

Economic development and diversification efforts are truly an investment in our future economic well-being and, unlike most other government-supported programs, a direct correlation can be established between the investment made and the return on that investment in the form of jobs and tax revenue generated. For example, every dollar invested by the government in NDA's recruitment efforts for the 2009-10 fiscal year will generate a return to state and local government of \$40 in tax revenue over the next five years.

The numbers make it clear that the investment in the NDA's mission pays dividends to our community in the form of immediate tax revenue, diversification of our economy and our tax base, as well as the creation of permanent jobs that continue to benefit our economy and our community for years to come. The NDA, with the assistance of Russell Rowe and The Capitol Company, will continue to advance its mission of economic development and diversification before our state and local governments and educate our policymakers as to how allocating resources to this endeavor is not only a smart investment, but a critically necessary one during these difficult economic times.

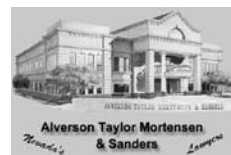

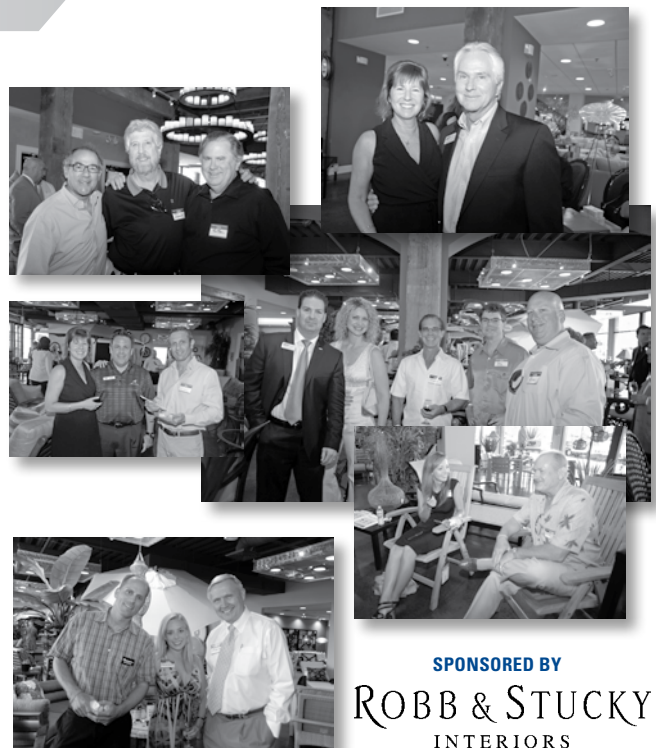

## **Adapt and Climb: Nevada's Economy in the Coming Decade**

Jeremy Aguero, principal analyst of Applied Analysis, a Nevada-based advisory firm, delivered a very detailed presentation to NDA members and guests at the NDA Board of Trustees' Breakfast meeting on Thursday, July 15th at the Four Seasons Hotel. Mr. Aguero, a fourth generation Nevadan, has become a trusted expert on Nevada's economy and real estate markets. His presentation titled "Adapt and Climb: Nevada's Economy in the Coming Decade" first gave a straight-forward look at the current shape of Nevada's economy by first pointing out the grim details such as our 14% unemployment rate, 189,300 people actively seeking jobs, 74% of homeowners upside down on their mortgages and a 7-year inventory of office space to name a few off the top.

"We are overweight" claims Mr. Aguero as he speaks of Nevada's 50,000 foreclosures in the past two years. "We grew by more than 4 percent per year during the boom and have contracted by more than 4 percent during the bust -- both nation leading. That said, it is the 1.3 percent growth rate over the past decade, when the boom and the bust are washed out, that is more compelling."

After playing "Dr. Doom" as Mr. Aguero put it, he then laid out a 10-year plan he believes will help Nevada get back on track. At the top of his list of eleven items was recommitting to economic development. "We need to reinvest in Nevada." While other states budget in the hundreds of millions for economic development, such as Michigan, Nevada sets aside a mere

\$5 million per year.

The revenue is there in reversions - a projected \$100 million is allocated. Nevada wouldn't feel the pinch if \$25 million was earmarked for economic development. Education, renewable energy and reducing government salaries were contenders on the list as well.
